on behalf of the Czech Republic,
of the Additional Protocol to the
Convention on Human Rights and Biomedicine,
concerning Biomedical Research.

On the eleventh day of May, Two thousand and Eighteen, at the seat of the Council of Europe in Strasbourg, Mr Emil RUFFER, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary, Permanent Representative of the Czech Republic to the Council of Europe, invested with full powers on behalf of his Government, signed the Additional Protocol to the Convention on Human Rights and Biomedicine, concerning Biomedical Research (CETS 195), which was opened for signature by Signatories to the Convention, in Strasbourg, on 25 January 2005.

In witness whereof this procès-verbal has been drawn up and signed by Mr Emil RUFFER and Mr Jörg POLAKIEWICZ, Director of Legal Advice and Public International Law (Legal Adviser) of the Council of Europe, in two copies, of which one will be handed to the Permanent Representative of the Czech Republic and the other deposited in the Archives of the Council of Europe.
